	Read Exodus 1-3. Discuss this passage with your parents. Discussion questions:  **It took great courage for the Egyptian midwives to deny the command of Pharaoh & spare the Israelite children. Why do you think they did this?  **Why is Moses an unlikely deliverer of the Israelites?  **Why do you think Exodus 3:14 is such a significant verse?	
	Read over your Names of God poster. Think about the story you have just read.  Answer the two questions on your chart for this passage.	
	<b>Memory Verse Passage:</b> <u>Joshua 1:7-9</u> . Be prepared to write out <i>verse 8</i> in class from memory next week. Use the card Mrs. Reese gave you in class so that we are all memorizing from the same version (NIV). Continue to review verse 7.
